Narrative: UNIT 54 RESPONDED TO SPEC FOR A 49 YEAR OLD MALE PT BEING SENT TO ST. MARY'S FOR FURTHER EVALUATION AND TREATMENT OF A DVT(S). THE PT IS ABOUT 6 DAYS POST BACK SURGERY IN WHICH HE HAD A HERNIATED DISK REPAIRED IN HIS LOWER LUMBAR AREA. THE PT HAS BEEN HAVING SOME PAIN IN HIS RIGHT LOWER LEG (CALF) SINCE FRIDAY WHICH HAS ONLY GOTTEN WORSE NOT BETTER. THE PT CAME INTO THE ER TODAY FOR AN EVALUATION OF THE PAIN AND WAS FOUND TO HAVE DVT(S) IN HIS LOWER LEG (RIGHT ONE). THE PT WAS GIVEN A CAPPED IV IN HIS RIGHT AC 20G, AND 100 MG OF LOVENOX SQ AT 1235. THE PT IS NOW BEING SENT TO ST. MARY'S IN PATIENT UNIT FOR CONTINUED CARE, ESPECIALLY DUE TO BEING ABOUT ONE WEEK POST SURGERY. THE PT HAD SOME LAB WORK DONE WHILE IN THE ER AS WELL INR: 1.00, WBC: 7.60, RBC: 4.90, HGB: 14.5, HCT: 41.7. UPON OUR ARRIVAL WE FOUND THE PT ALERT AND ORIENTED X4 LAYING IN THE ER BED WITH HEAD ELEVATED, SKIN PINK, WARM, AND DRY, CHEST RISE AND FALL =, CMS +, PUPILS PERRL. THE PT HAD NO COMPLAINTS OF ANY KIND AT THE TIME OF TRANSPORT. THE PT MOVED TO THE COT AND WAS SECURED X3 WITH HEAD ELEVATED, THEN MOVED TO THE RIG. PT'S VITALS WERE CHECKED AND RECHECKED. HE WAS TRANSPORTED WITHOUT INCIDENT OR CHANGES. PT CARE, REPORT, AND PAPERS WERE GIVEN TO THE NURSE AT ROOM 7633 WHERE WE TRANSFERRED CARE.
