Narrative: RB 49 DISPATCHED FOR AN IMMEDIATE PICK UP A 71 Y.O. MALE WHO WAS COMPLAINING OF SEVERE RIGHT FOOT AND ANKLE PAIN. THE PATIENT HAD MAJOR SURGERY ON THE DAY PRIOR TO CALLING AND WAS DISCHARGED HOME. PER THE PATIENT, AT ABOUT 0400 THIS MORNING, THE PATIENT'S SURGERY MEDICATIONS WORE OFF AND HIS FOOT AND ANKLE PAIN BECAME INCREASINGLY PAINFUL. HE ATTEMPTED TO CONTROL THE PAIN WITH RX OXYCODONE AND ADVIL WITHOUT SUCCESS. AT THE TIME OF PICK UP THE PATIENT RATED HIS PAIN AT 9.5/10. THE PATIENT'S APARTMENT WAS TWO FLIGHTS OF STEPS, 27 TOTAL, FROM THE ROAD LEVEL. THE PATIENT WAS PIVOT TRANSFERRED FROM HIS CHAIR TO THE STAIR CHAIR. THE PATIENT KEPT HIS FOOT ELEVATED WITH HIS OWN STRENGTH AS HIS FOOT PAIN BECAME WORSE IF IT WAS NOT ELEVATED. THE PATIENT WAS SECURED TO THE STAIR CHAIR. THE STAIR CHAIR AS WHEELED TO THE EDGE OF THE STEPS AND TIPPED BACK TO THE ANGLE OF THE REAR STAIR TRACK. STAIR TRACK USED TO SLIDE THE PATIENT DOWN THE FIRST SET OF 15 STEPS. THE PATIENT WAS THEN WHEELED OUTSIDE THE APARTMENT AND, USING THE SAME METHOD, LOWERED DOWN THE 12 OUTSIDE STEPS TO STREET LEVEL. ONCE AT STREET LEVEL THE PATIENT WAS PIVOT TRANSFERRED FROM THE STAIR CHAIR TO THE LOWERED COT. PATIENT SECURED TO THE COT AND COVERED WITH BLANKETS. THE COT WAS RAISED AND LOADED INTO THE RIG. VITALS OBTAINED BY CREW. BP ELEVATED. OTHER VS WNL. PAIN SCALE 9.5/10. THE PATIENT WAS OFFERED IV PAIN MEDICATION BY RN CW BUT THE PATIENT STATED THAT HE'D LIKE TO WAIT UNTIL HE GOT TO THE STM ED. TOES OF THE RIGHT FOOT APPEARED TO HAVE GOOD COLOR INDICATING ADEQUATE CIRCULATION AND THE REST OF THE FOOT WAS HEAVILY WRAPPED. UNABLE TO CHECK CAPILLARY REFILL OF THE RIGHT TOES BECAUSE OF THE PAIN IT WOULD CAUSE. TRANSPORT INITIATED. VS REOBTAINED Q15 MINUTES. PAIN REMAINED CONSTANT AT 9.5/10. RADIO REPORT GIVEN AT 8 MINUTES OUT. SHORTLY AFTER THE RADIO REPORT WAS GIVEN THE PATIENT BECAME NAUSEOUS AND VOMITED INTO A RB EMESIS BAG. THE PATIENT DENIED THAT THIS WAS BECAUSE OF PAIN AND STATED THAT HIS PAIN MEDICATION HAS HAD HIM FEELING UNEASY ON AND OFF ALL DAY. THE REMAINDER OF THE
